James (Outline)

I. Opening of the Letter with Greeting

 (Verse 1) ... James identifies himself as "a <u>SERVANT</u> of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ". Though James is the half brother of Jesus (Matthew 13:55) and is highly respected among the Christian community (Acts 15:13 & Galatians 2:9) ... he recognizes his true role as SERVANT. He addresses the "twelve tribes which are scattered abroad." Though this could be an indication of an early date of the writing (when most Christians were Jewish) it could also refer to the fact that the TRUE Israel of God is the Church composed of ALL Christians.
