FIRST DEPORTATION OF JUDAH BY BABYLONIANS UNDER NEBUCHADNEZZAR IN 605 B.C. DURING REIGN OF JEHOAKIM OF JUDAH - DANIEL (605-536) TO JEWS IN BABYLON - Daniel wrote during time of Nebuchadnezzar (King of Babylon) to Cyrus (1st King of the Medo-Persian Empire). He also refers to Darius' reign who has been identified as Gubaru, a governor appointed by Cyrus.						
BABYLONIANS CONQUERED & DEPORTED JUDAH UNDER NEBUCHADNEZZAR IN 586 B.C.						
Nebuchadnezzar (605-562) had four successors from 562-539. Belshazzar who ruled jointly with Nabonidus lost the kingdom to Cyrus (539-530) (Medo-Persian Empire) in 539 B.C. Cyrus allowed Zerubbabel to take 50,000 Jews back to Jerusalem in 536 B.C. During Darius I (521-486) reign Haggai (520) & Zechariah (520-480) prophesied to Judah to encourage a rebuilding of Jerusalem. During Ahasuerus (Xerxes) (485-465) reign, he married Esther and the Jewish nation was spared. During Artaxerxes I (465-424) reign he allowed Ezra's return (458) & Nehemiah's return (444). Malachi wrote to Judah in 430.
